Finger Waves

FACE SHAPE: DIAMOND
CHRISTO'S DIY TIPS:

- Start with dry hair and part between six and eight different sections.
- Use a two-inch curling iron to create a curl starting at the nape of your neck.
- Then, loop the curl around your finger so it looks like a circle and secure it onto your head with a bobby pin.
- Once you finish one section, spritz it with some more hairspray and proceed to the next until you finish the entire head.
- Let the hair set for five minutes. Next, release the bobby pins, create a side part and comb your hair with a brush with flexible nylon bristles to create a soft side curl.
- Secure one side behind the ear with a twinkly barrette and finish with a shine serum.

FACE SHAPE: ROUND
DEAN'S DIY TIPS:

- Shampoo and condition the hair with thickening products.
- Blow-dry tresses upside down until dry to create maximum volume.
- Use a light hairspray and put texture in the hair with a curling iron so your ponytail is full of life and bounce.
- Put backcomb in the crown with a firm-hold hairspray and a narrow-tooth comb. Pull the hair into a ponytail keeping it high on the head and in line with your cheekbones.
- Secure it with an elastic band. Take a piece of hair and wrap it around to hide the elastic; bobby pin it in place.

Messy Updo

FACE SHAPE: HEART
DEAN'S DIY TIPS:

- After shampooing and conditioning hair with a volumizing shampoo and conditioner, blow-dry upside down to create as much body as possible.
- Next, take small sections of hair and create tight curls all over your head with a one-inch curling iron.
- After the entire head is curled, finger through to break the curls up and to give them a more natural, tousled look.
- Use a styling putty to create a little bit of moveable texture.
- Now, gather sections of hair and pull up and back, pinning the pieces off your neck with bobby pins.
- Loosely pull back the crown area of the hair from the face. Secure with bobby pins.
- Finish with hairspray.
